

Genevieve Bujold, Fritz Weaver in 'Antigone'

8:30 - 10 (13) **PLAYHOUSE NEW YORK** - Classics For Today. "Antigone." Powerful, demanding and dramatically exciting evening in the theatre. In performance, it breathes a contemporary feel into the ancient Greek classic by Sophocles, as playwright Jean Anouilh who adapted it, intended. It also boasts a cast equal to the intellectual and emotional conflicts it develops. Introduced by Stacy Keach who plays the Greek chorus in a quiet, yet intense conversational tone, he sets the stage for the tragedy to come following King Creon's order that the body of Antigone's brother must lie on the ground unburied for the vultures to dispose of. The rest of the play is a battle between young Antigone, pure in heart and strong in courage, and her uncle King Creon, cultivated and analytical, but tyrannical in his

love of power. This is a beautiful play about conscience and the spirit of hope, versus the surrender of both for the fruits of tyranny. Genevieve Bujold and Fritz Weaver are simply magnificent as the play's antagonists, Antigone and Creon.

9 - 10 (7) **THE STREETS OF SAN FRANCISCO**. "Forty-Five Minutes From Home." Another absorbing murder case that should keep viewers watching to the conclusion. A young girl is murdered on a houseboat and though we know who the murderer is from the start, the drama stems from the clues leading to an innocent middle-aged conventioner, who thinks he has accidentally killed the girl. William Windom plays the troubled visiting salesman.

9 - 10 (2) **THE BOB NEWHART SHOW**. Back-to-back

comedy episodes on CBS tonight about mothers. Psychologist Hartley reveals his guilt feelings about Mother, and resolves to come out finally and tell Mom he loves her. Wife Emily plays the listener, allowing Hartley to talk about his past. Star Newhart specializes in this kind of uneasy, guilt-ridden situation and, thankfully, he has been given enough humorous dialogue to carry it off.

10 - 11 (2) **MISSION: IMPOSSIBLE**. Singer Robert Goulet should attract the ladies, playing a bad guy, a syndicate crime boss. Conned by Mission agents into believing his wife played around once with another hood, Goulet's character takes revenge. Written by mystery expert Howard Browne, the episode moves up a notch over recent shows.
